Two Getting Ahead While Getting Out Classes Graduated on Monday, October 3, 2016

Monday, October 3rd, was graduation day for the latest "Getting Ahead" classes in the Garland County Detention Center. This group of graduates consisted of fifteen inmates and another completed the course, but was unable to attend the graduation. The attendees included Mike and Deby Prince, class facilitators; Dorelle Hogan and Dian Glover, class co-facilitators; Sheriff Mike McCormick; and Ltnt. Belinda Cosgrove. Sam Cooke would have been proud of the soulful performance of his song, "Change Gonna Come" that was performed by one of the graduates, Joshua Weeks, accompanied by Dian Glover on the piano.

"Getting Ahead While Getting Out" is one of many educational program opportunities that are now available in the new detention facility. This is the 6th and 7th class to complete the course, which has proven to be one of the most frequently requested programs offered at GCDC. The While Getting Out program is designed for people who are returning to their communities from correctional facilities and jails. It is a prisoner re-entry model to reduce recidivism through learning, building resources, accountability and collaboration. CCMC has been able to offer this program with the partnership and support of Sheriff McCormick, Ltnt. Cosgrove, and the staff of the
